Canberra Brickworks Update

Request for proposals

The ACT Government issued an open request for proposals to develop the Canberra Brickworks Precinct earlier this year. Proposals needed to address certain objectives and parameters formulated by a Community Panel consisting of representative groups such as the YRA. These objectives and parameters were based on extensive consultation with our members and the wider community, while a set of draft objectives were circulated to YRA members via email for comment early in the process.

Shortlisted proposals

The Community Panel, which includes five members of the YRA Committee, reviewed the proposals and provided feedback to the evaluation panel on how proponents addressed the objectives and parameters. A short list of 2 developers/consortiums was finalised on August 26 and the two proponents will be invited into a request for tender (RFT) process due to start in October 2016.

Further opportunities for community input

The wider community will have further opportunities for input and scrutiny and we will keep our members informed in a timely manner. Meanwhile, YRA Community Panel members will work hard to ensure the two competing proponents and the ACT government adhere to the objectives and parameters in the best possible way to achieve the best outcome for the community.
