The sale contract between the ACT government and DOMA, the successful bidder, has still not been completed. The Suburban Land Agency has advised us the latest draft contract is with DOMA for their comments. It is hoped that comments will be received by the end of November.

YRA Submission on 2019-20 ACT **Budget Deliberations**

YRA has lodged a submission calling for funding to be allocated for planning for a Mint Interchange, signalisation of Novar/Dudley St and Adelaide Ave/Kent St and various road safety measures in Yarralumla. The submission also called for funding to commence initial planning for a Yarralumla Wetland. Finally, assurance was sought that any necessary budget allocation associated with the Brickworks development would be included in the Budget and that funding would be available to support the implementation of the recommendations arising out of the discussions on Better Suburbs.

Stakeholder contact

The YRA has recently held discussions with Transport Canberra and City Services to address various traffic and other issues in Yarralumla. We have also had a series of meetings and walk-arounds with local politicians and other stakeholders to show them some of the issues facing Yarralumla including the derelict building site on the corner of Bentham St and Hutchins St. YRA has also written to the Minister for Regulatory Services Mr Gordon Ramsay regarding the poor condition of the YMCA Auxiliary Hall on the corner of Loftus and Mueller St and has asked if the Hall can be returned to community use if it is not going to be used by the YMCA.

Volunteer tree maintenance group

Our volunteer group held more than 12 working bees across the suburb during the autumn and winter and many residents have commented on the improvements in the areas they worked on. The team is having a break as TCCS does not have the capacity to collect the group's prunings due to their summer mowing commitments.
